

ABO CODES OF CONDUCT FOR JUNIORS

Adaptive Boxing Organisation CiC is fully committed to safeguarding and promoting the wellbeing of all its members. The organisation believes that it is important that members, coaches, staff and parents associated with the club should, at all times, show respect and understanding for safety and welfare of others. As a member of ABO you are expected to abide by the following junior code of conduct.

- All members must play within the rules and respect officials and their decisions.
- All members must respect rights, dignity and worth of all participants regardless of gender, ability, cultural or religious background.
- Members should keep to their agreed training and competition times, informing the appropriate person if going to be late or not attending.
- Members must wear suitable kit for training and competitions, as agreed with manager/coach.
- Members must pay fees promptly.
- Junior members are not allowed to smoke on club premises or whilst representing the club.
- Junior members are not allowed to consume alcohol or drugs of any kind on the club premises or whilst representing the club.
- Members should conduct themselves in a professional manner when representing the club.

A failure to abide by these rules will result in your exclusion from the sessions and removal from the building/ Events.
